

RELEASE REGARDING FAMILY SELF-SUFFICIENCY FUNDING:

Delegation Announces More Than \$200,000 in Grants to Help North Dakota Families

Grants to Help Economically Vulnerable Families Achieve Self-Sufficiency

Washington - Senators Kent Conrad and John Hoeven and Congressman Rick Berg today announced that the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has awarded three North Dakota communities a total of \$203,672 in federal funds to help provide economically vulnerable families with affordable housing opportunities.

“This funding will help families in need work toward achieving economic independence and stability,” the delegation said in a joint statement.

The Fargo Housing and Redevelopment Authority will receive \$55,675. The Minot Housing Authority will receive \$43,612. The Housing Authority of the City of Grand Forks will receive \$104,385.

The grants were awarded through HUD’s Family Self-Sufficiency program, an initiative that helps families in public housing make progress toward economic independence and self-sufficiency.
